How to Access Your Information on the Web

- Go to www.13network.com
- Scroll down to “Texas”
- Choose “Ray Hendren (Waco Division)”
- Click on “Chapter 13 Inquiry”
- Click on “Yes I agree with the above Information”
- Your **User ID** is your case number (seven digits, no dashes, no other characters)
- Your **Password** is the last four (4) digits of your Social Security Number
- Click “Submit”

The first page, “Case Profile” will show you a snapshot of some of the information currently available to the Trustee, including the Balance on Hand, Last Receipt Date, your address, etc.

The “Parties” tab will show you all of the entities who are associated with you case: Type, Name and Address.

The “Pay Scheds” tab gives a breakdown of your plan payment schedules, as well as what payments are/were expected vs. payments received, and shows delinquent amounts. Note: Calculated delinquency is based on Court Ordered plan payments, not necessarily on pending proposed plan payments.

The “Payees” tab summarizes which parties, such as creditors and your attorney, are being paid in the case. By clicking the underlined “Name” you will be able to see more detail about the claim filed by any creditor, or, if no claim was filed, you will see the information you included in your debt schedules.

The “Financials” tab is a ledger type recap that shows what payments were posted to your case, and what disbursements were made from those payments. You may sort this information by clicking on a heading.
